In honor of the feast of St. Francis of Assisi, patron saint of animals and nature, pets are welcome to come to school at 2:45 to be blessed on this day. Please follow these guidelines:

- **Parents must bring pets to school no earlier than 2:40 for the blessing, stay with the pets during the blessing, and leave with the pets after the blessing.**
- Please make sure pets are under control – dogs and cats should be on a leash or in a kennel, smaller animals can attend in their cage.
- Only bring your pet if you know they are comfortable with other animals and crowds. **DO NOT** bring your pet if you are unsure how they will behave in the presence of other animals or a large amount of people. We want all of our students and all of the pets to be safe!
- If pets are not able to attend, Fr. Chad will be happy to bless a picture of a pet, instead!
- If you don't have a pet, you are welcome to bring a stuffed animal to be blessed.
