DEAR PASTORATE FAMILY,

We are so excited to work together as a united Music Ministry beginning on July 1! In response to many questions, we wanted to provide an overview of how liturgies will sound beginning July 1. In short, the focus of this first year is continuity.

There will be no changes in the general repertoire choices at each of the three churches.

The only substantial changes include:

4pm Saturday Mass will be Low Mass (no music).

7:30am Sunday Mass will also be Low Mass, however, hymns will be offered at the Procession, Recession, and Communion.

5pm Saturday, 9am & 10:30am Sunday Masses will all be High Masses with music appropriate to the principal Mass of Sunday.

This structure of having more solemn and less solemn Masses in the same weekend will hopefully provide better for the needs of those with weekend work schedules, unique travel or mobility circumstances, or otherwise need a shorter offering of Mass. Inversely, this will also allow us to pour more energy into the principal Masses on Sunday. This ordering of weekend Masses reflects the suggestions of the Second Vatican Council and common practice throughout history in light of practical and theological considerations.

Existing Choirs will also not change this year. The Christ the King Choir will sing for the 9am Mass at CTK each Sunday and the Immaculate Heart of Mary Choir will sing at IHM for 10:30am Mass each Sunday. The Choirs will likely combine for major feast days and other occasions as appropriate.

Children's choir opportunities will not only continue but, God willing, expand to include all school-age children and mirror the excellent musical formation which already exists and has proven successful at IHM School.

Music forms an integral part of Catholic liturgical life, which has as its source and culmination the Holy Mass which is a gift from us to the Lord. All of our labor, all of our singing, is offered in fulfillment of the greatest commandment which is to love the Lord our God with all of our heart, mind, soul, and strength. With this singular mission in mind, we look forward to a bright future of beautiful prayer and worship in Pastorate 26.

Music Staff Biographies



Director of Sacred Music, Michael Mills

Michael Mills, a native of Lodi, Wisconsin is excited to assist in the direction of Pastorate Music! Michael completed studies in organ and church music at the University of Kansas culminating in the Master of Music in Church Music degree in 2021. While a student at KU, Michael studied organ with James Higdon, Olivier Latry and choral conducting with Michael Bauer. During his studies, Michael also had the opportunity to spend multiple summers in the Netherlands playing in masterclass for teachers including Guy Bovet, Leo van Doeselaar, and Lorenzo Ghielmi. While in Kansas City, Michael served multiple parishes and developed a Children's Choir in the heart of Kansas City at Our Lady of Good Counsel Parish. In addition to regular service as an organist and choir director, Michael also spent significant time researching the development

of Catholic liturgy and was invited to offer seminar courses in the history of Catholic art and liturgy at the St. Lawrence Catholic Campus Center at the University of Kansas in Lawrence, Kansas and the Chesterton Academy of St. Philip Neri in Kansas City, Missouri.

Michael currently serves on the Board of the Madison Area Association of Church Musicians (American Guild of Organists) and assists the Diocese of Madison - Office of Worship with Diocesan liturgies. Michael is a member of the Knights of Columbus and enjoys volunteering outside of the choral season. Outside of music, Michael enjoys spending time exploring the beautiful Wisconsin countryside, reading, traveling, and golf.

Soprano Andrea Wiltzius was recognized by The New York Times for her "warm, passionate and dramatic leaning," voice. She has been celebrated for her work performing the title roles of *Suor Angelica*, *Manon Lescaut*, *Tosca*, *Margherita* in Boito's *Mefistofele*, and *Liu* in *Turandot* amongst many others. Highlights of Ms. Wiltzius' opera career include performing on the stages of the Salzburg Festival, The National Theatre of Prague, Opera di Firenze, Festspielhaus Baden-Baden, Glyndebourne, Canadian Opera Company, Lyric Opera of Chicago, Lyric Opera of Baltimore, and as understudy at the Bayreuth Festspielhaus

through the American Wagner Project for Young Dramatic Voices.

While traveling throughout the world, Ms. Wiltzius has served as either Music Director, Choir Director, or cantor for many churches including: Grace & St. Peter's Episcopal Church Baltimore, Chizuk Amuno Synagogue of Baltimore, The Baltimore Basilica, Roland Park Presbyterian Church, St. David's Episcopal of Baltimore, Yorkminster Baptist Church of Toronto, Beth Tikvah Synagogue of Toronto, and others.

A native of Kohler, Wisconsin, Andrea was a parishioner and sang at St. John's Catholic Church in Kohler. Upon graduation, she went on to receive the Bachelor of Music degree from Indiana University, Master of Music in Vocal Performance from The Peabody Institute of Johns Hopkins University, and has completed advanced studies in Percussion Performance at the University of Wisconsin.

Andrea is thrilled to be part of the Pastorate 26 family! She resides in Madison with her husband, Dr. Christopher Pierce (also a musician!), and her daughter, August (named after St. Augustine). In her spare time, she enjoys exercise with her dog, Dolly Parton, playing with her FOUR cats (don't ask), enjoying family time in Door County and Eagle River, and feeding her thrifting and shopping addiction at St. Vinnies.
